EXECUTIVE ORDER #170

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff in Memory of Lincoln County Highway Department Employee Marcus Wydeven

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, July 14, 2015, Marcus Wydeven, an employee of the Lincoln County Highway Department, died from injuries suffered in a tragic vehicle crash while working as a flagger on U.S. Highway 17; and

WHEREAS, Marcus Wydeven served his community as an employee of the Lincoln County Highway Department for almost 20 years; and

WHEREAS, Marcus Wydeven, a native of Wisconsin, leaves behind a legacy of service as a member of the Lincoln County community, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Marcus Wydeven on Saturday, July 25, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Lincoln County has petitioned the Office of the Governor to approve the lowering of the flags;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff in Lincoln County beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, July 25, 2015**, and ending at sunset on that date.
